

Pieceful Mountain Quilt Guild
Meeting: February 11, 2010
Next meeting: March 11, 2010

The meeting was called to order by President Diane Head. The minutes were read and accepted.

Linda Kimsey gave the treasurer's report which was read and accepted. There is a balance as of 12/31 of \$2,280.42, deposits of \$330.60 of dues, and \$244.40 for the retreat for a total deposit of \$575. The checking account has \$1380.63 and the retreat account has \$14,74.79 for an ending balance of \$2855.42 .

Scottie will check with the Chamber of Commerce to about getting our name on their list. Linda will get our guild brochure to the Chamber of Commerce.

The picture of our officers was in last week's paper. So we are trying to get the word out that we exist and are thriving.

There are now only 14 going to the retreat, June 17-20 and we have to actively recruit to get the price break. The price includes one pattern (either a table runner or lap quilt) and also covers the instructor fees and housing. Emails will be sent to update everyone.

There was a discussion about the meeting place: bank charges \$60/day; church requires liability insurance \$113/year and they will be getting back to us after the church council meets and discusses it.

Nedra reported on the statistics that the guild has accumulated...since 2004, the guild has donated 260 donation quilts, and also stuffed animals, stuff for Empty Stocking, walker bags, pillow cases and purses. Great job everyone!

A day work meeting was held and four people attended and sewed together 32 blocks. They have 88 more blocks pinned together for the next work session. Diane showed us the blocks and explained that they are "quilt as you go." She also showed a king size finished one that she had completed.

The Round Robin finished projects were shown and were wonderful to see.

The meeting was adjourned.
